Calgary Arts Academy provides Arts Immersion teaching and learning, focusing on high expectations and academic excellence. We serve students who are passionate about Arts Immersion learning and pure art form instruction in five art forms: music, drama, dance, visual and literary arts!

Learning Facilitators include teachers (who are artists in their own right) and artists who partner with teachers in the planning and delivery of Arts Immersion instruction. Music, drama, visual art, dance and literary art are the core focus areas in the delivery of the Alberta Curriculum.

Students work with many Learning Facilitators (teachers and artists) during the school day. Students are required to travel to several learning spaces during the day in multi-aged groups.

Community engagement is high. Students are required to demonstrate respect when working with partner organizations, the arts community and volunteers.

In order to facilitate academic excellence, all students are expected to self-monitor behaviour and actively engage in all learning opportunities.

Students complete learning contracts which are individualized. (as required.)

Parents are partners in teaching and learning and actively participate in the creation, support and completion of all learning contracts.

Calgary Arts Academy offers a strength based approach in support of inclusive education. Specialized programs include:

- Math intervention
- Reading intervention
- Short term counselling support
- Short term behaviour support
- Individualized learning contracts (remediation, enrichment)
- Small group remediation /enrichment groups

Important to Note

1. Calgary Arts Academy delivers the Alberta curriculum through Arts Immersion. Students are required to participate in music, drama, dance, visual art and literary art.
2. Calgary Arts Academy operates on a first-come, first-served basis, with siblings of current students taking priority. Upon receipt, applications are reviewed for completeness and are date-stamped to ensure correct placement on the wait lists. Applications are reviewed for applicant eligibility when the applicant's name appears next on the wait list.
3. All documents (please see the checklist below) plus payment of a \$50.00 admin fee must be received before your child's name is placed on the wait list.
4. Calgary Arts Academy individualizes learning through learning contracts that are created in collaboration with learning facilitators, parents and students.

Alternatively, you can phone the school with your credit card information. Applications are prioritized on our wait lists on first-come, first-served basis.
