- Calgary Arts Academy delivers the Alberta curriculum through Arts Immersion. Students are required to participate in all art forms.
- Calgary Arts Academy operates on a first-come, first-served basis, with siblings of current students taking priority. Upon receipt, applications are reviewed for completeness and are date stamped to ensure correct placement on the wait lists. Applications are reviewed for applicant eligibility when the applicant's name appears next on the wait list.
- Students will be contacted when their name is next on the wait list to audition. More information on how to audition will be provided.
- All documents (please see the checklist below), plus payment of a \$50.00 admin fee must be received before your child's name is placed on the wait list.
